

## Post-school destinations

- Only Victorian, Queensland and Western Australian data are available for 2010.
- The data may differ from school-specific exit data.

### Queensland

The source of Queensland post-school destination data is the annual *Next Step* survey, collected from Year 12 completers approximately six months after they have left school. The data includes all students including international, fee-paying, and visa students. Students from Queensland who were offered a university placement but deferred have been reported according to their engagement at the time of the survey.

Due to confidentiality reasons schools with fewer than five respondents are not reported.

Year 12 completers undertaking an Apprenticeship or Traineeship are categorised into TAFE/Vocational study.

### Victoria

This data does not include international students.

The source of this post-school destination data is *On Track* survey data, collected from school leavers six months after they have left school. Data from most Victorian secondary schools have been included in the table. The remaining schools have not been included because the numbers of completing students, or the numbers of students responding to the post-school destination survey, were insufficient to provide reliable data.

Victorian students who gained but deferred taking up a bachelor place are not included in this data. Transition rates to university and employment for Victorian schools should be interpreted in this context.

Victorian students may enrol in a bachelor degree at both a university and a TAFE.

Multi-campus school data have been rolled.

### Western Australia

The destination calculations are based on students who were in Year 12 in 2010 in August and responded to the survey conducted in March 2011. The source of the data is the *WA School Leaver Survey 2011*. Because it is survey data, it may differ from school specific exit data. For statistical reliability, the following notes apply:

- Schools with fewer than 11 respondents have not been included in the dataset.
- Schools with responding students totalling less than 50% of their second semester year 12 student count have not been included in the dataset.

Students from Western Australia who were offered a university placement but deferred have been reported according to their engagement at the time of the survey.
