When you successfully submit your request, you will receive an automated email. If you do not receive this email within a minute, it is likely because you already have a My School Principals' Portal account. Therefore, you should try <u>resetting your password</u>.

Before you log in, ACARA must manually authorise your request. This may involve contacting your school to confirm that you are the principal. You will receive another email when your request has been authorised and then you can log in (see Logging in).

Resetting your password

If you have a My School Principals' Portal account but have forgotten your password, please visit the <u>'Reset password' page</u>.

When you click 'Submit', you will receive an automated email containing a link to reset your password. The password you create must contain a minimum of 10 characters, including at least one upper-case letter, a lower-case letter, a number and one of the following symbols: @\$!#%*?&.

Please note you only have 24 hours to click the link in this automated email before it expires. If you do not receive this automated email within a minute, you should <u>request access</u>.

Updating your details

To update your details (including the school you are connected to), click the 'Modify my details' button (circled green in figure 2, above). You can update your first and last name and contact number.

You cannot update your email address as this is your user log in name. Therefore, if your email address has changed, please email <u>portalsupportenquiries@acara.edu.au</u> and let us know what your email used to be and what it is now.

To add a school to your account, start typing the school name in the 'Add school' field and select from the drop-down menu. To delete a school, click on the cross next to that school in the 'My schools' field under the 'Remove' column.

Once you have updated all your details, click the 'Submit' button located underneath the 'My schools' field.

Previewing your My School data

After a successful log-in, to preview your school please click the 'Preview school' button (circled orange in figure 2). The school you are connected to will be displayed in the header of the page (circled yellow in figure 2). If this school is not correct, you will need to <u>update</u> <u>your details</u>.

Updating your school comment

You are encouraged to prepare your school comment in an offline document and then copy it into the text editor, as for security reasons the site will log you out after 15 minutes of inactivity, which can result in losing work if you type directly into the 'Revised school comments' text box.

After a successful log in, you will see the 'Edit' icon underneath the 'School comments currently published on My School website' (circled green in figure 4 below). When you click on this icon, a 'Revised school comments' text box appears for you to edit.
