| Inclusion of school types | - Must be a school as defined by the National School Statistics Collection (NSSC) <br> - School must have formal school curriculum work such as Mathematic, English, etc. Schools entirely devoted to one program for example swimming schools etc. - are not included, <br> - School sectors included: Catholic systemic schools as Catholic sector, Catholic non-systemic schools and independent schools as Independent sector. <br> - Excursion days from a regular or special school as part of the school program are included. <br> - Solely camping schools are not included e.g., summer camp/vacation programs, no formal curriculum. |
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| Inclusion of students | - Classified as inactive if they have not attended in any school days/s during the reference period. If the student has been identified as enrolled and attending at another school, then this non-attendance can be excluded from being reported. If after 6 weeks of consecutive days non-attendance a student cannot be located to confirm if they remain enrolled at the school, then this non-attendance is excluded from being reported. <br> - Ungraded student included if they are within the typical age groups for students in grade/years 1 to 10, a full-time student, attends at least one day during the reference period. <br> - Exchange, Full fee-paying overseas students (FFPOS) and temporary visa students are excluded if they were enrolled and active at a school overseas immediately prior to coming to Australia and are in Australia for less than 12 months. <br> - Permanent visa students need to meet the criteria of a full-time student. <br> - Where a student attends multiple schools part-time and those parttime amounts equal full-time (i.e., full-time at state level), then the student is considered as full-time for the purpose of student attendance. |
| Level of disaggregation | - The Education Department collects and provides non-specified sex, ACARA will allocate to sex as per ACARA methodology. <br> - ABS Remoteness is sourced from school Latitude/Longitude matched with ABS digital boundaries using the Spatial Enablement tool. <br> - Schools located at; Cocos/Keeling Island, Christmas Island are classified in WA, Jervis Bay classified in ACT, Norfolk Island classified in QLD. |

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|  | - Non-systemic Catholic schools are classified as independent sector schools. |
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| Student attributes | - The Education Department does not capture student attribute changes. The data technical specification advises how data submission are to treat changes of school during collection period. If a student who changes school has not been attending for 6 continuous weeks (without a known reason) then the enrolment is deemed to have ceased at the day of the last attendance. |
| Part-day absences | - ACARA's guidance on part day absence is applied. |
| Authorised absences | - Per attendance reporting standard <br> - Where a Catholic System Office or Independent school queries how to treat a circumstance outside the standards then DESE would pass on ACARA's advice (e.g., COVID-19) |
| Attendance rate and level calculation formula | - Minimum 1 day enrolled to be included <br> - A school can report part day attendance as part of the cohort attendance days as this attribute allows up to two decimal places <br> - Possible student days is an integer value. <br> - The Education Department collects the possible student days for greater than or equal to $90 \%$ attendance from the school as part of the cohort data. Schools are responsible for applying rounding and any non-attendance exclusion before submitting to Education. |
