| Inclusion of students | - Attendance is collected for all Queensland state school students with an active fulltime enrolment during the reporting period (Semester 1 or Term 3). <br> - After 15 consecutive days of unexplained absence, schools may change a student's enrolment status to inactive. Attendance recorded prior to this status change is reported. <br> - Students' year levels are reported as recorded by the school. Schools may assign ungraded students to an age-equivalent year level.
